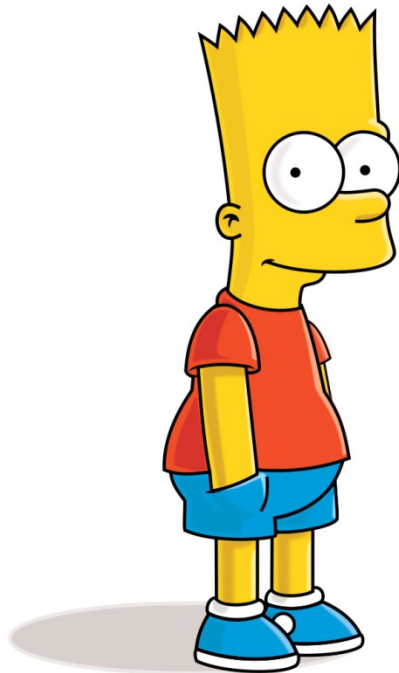
You can remember all the little details but you just can't remember his name! Here's one of 350 Name Blank questions that are in the game.

Rules of the Game

Players: 2-4

Object: To score the most points by answering 5 questions and by predicting whether your opponents can do the same.

Contents: 1 set of question cards (12 cards with 5 questions per card in the prototype), 8 prediction cards (4- "YES" and 4-"NO"), 1 score pad, and 1 pencil.

To Play:

Give each player 1 question card and two "Prediction" cards, (1-Yes" and 1-"No").

Enter each player's name on the score sheet starting with the player to your left as Player #1 and continuing clockwise until all have been entered.

The game starts with "Player #1". You, as the player to their right, read aloud the uppermost question from the card you are holding. Player #1 does **NOT** answer at this time. You and the other players must first decide whether Player #1 will be able to correctly answer the question, and then make your predictions by placing a "Yes" or a "No" card FACE DOWN on the table in front of you.

Player #1 must answer the question. If he/she is able to give the correct answer, he/she gets 2 points, which is entered next to "Player #1 Question" and under his/her name. You and the other players now reveal your predictions. Each "Yes" prediction scores 1 point, which is entered underneath the player's name in the top row.

Play passes to the left where Player #1 reads the first question on his/her question card aloud for Player #2 to answer. You and the other players make your predictions. The answer is attempted by Player #2, and if it is correct scores 2 points. Those making the correct prediction, score 1 point.

Winning the Game

Play continues following the above rules until each player has answered all 5 questions. The scores are totaled, and the player with the most points is the winner.
