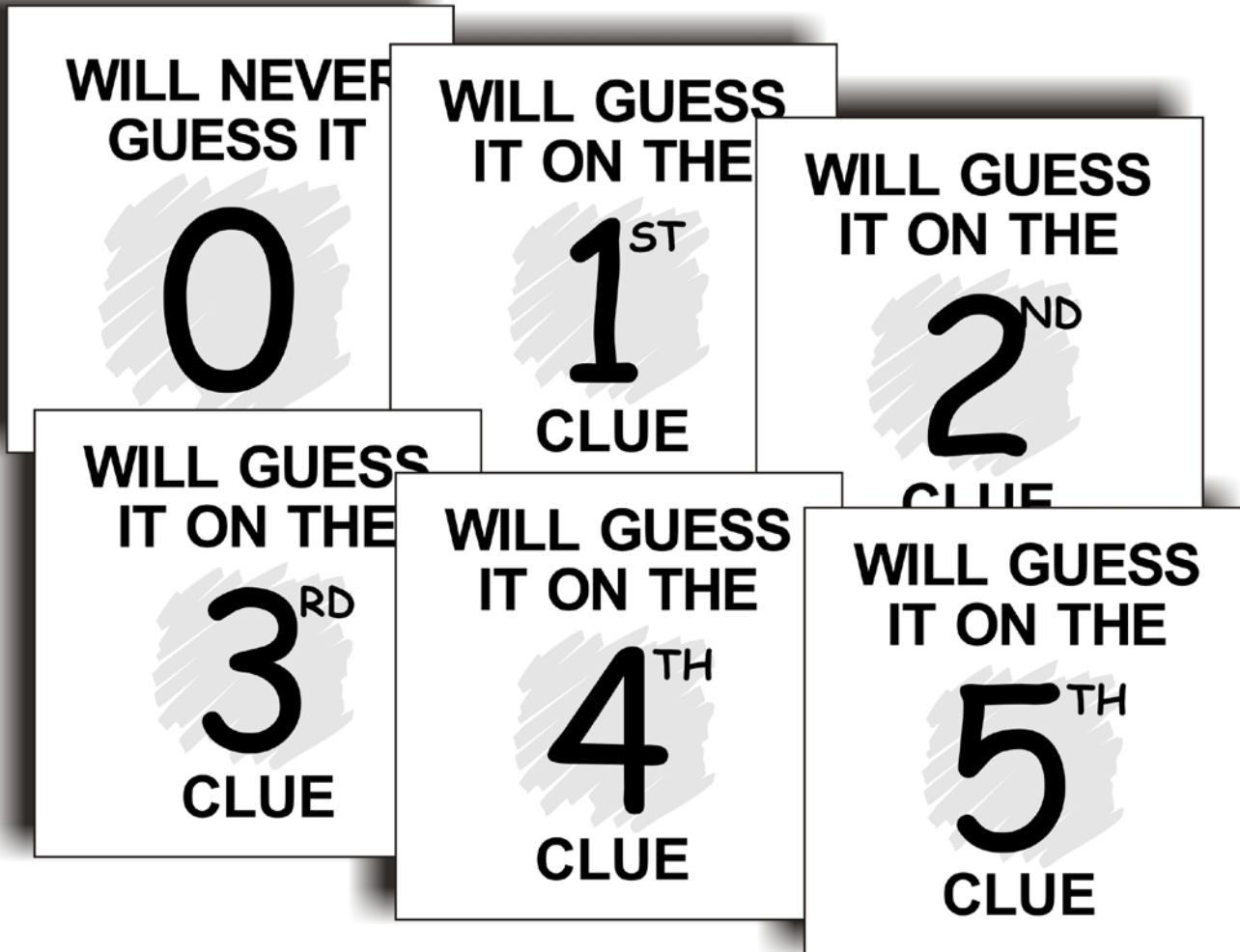


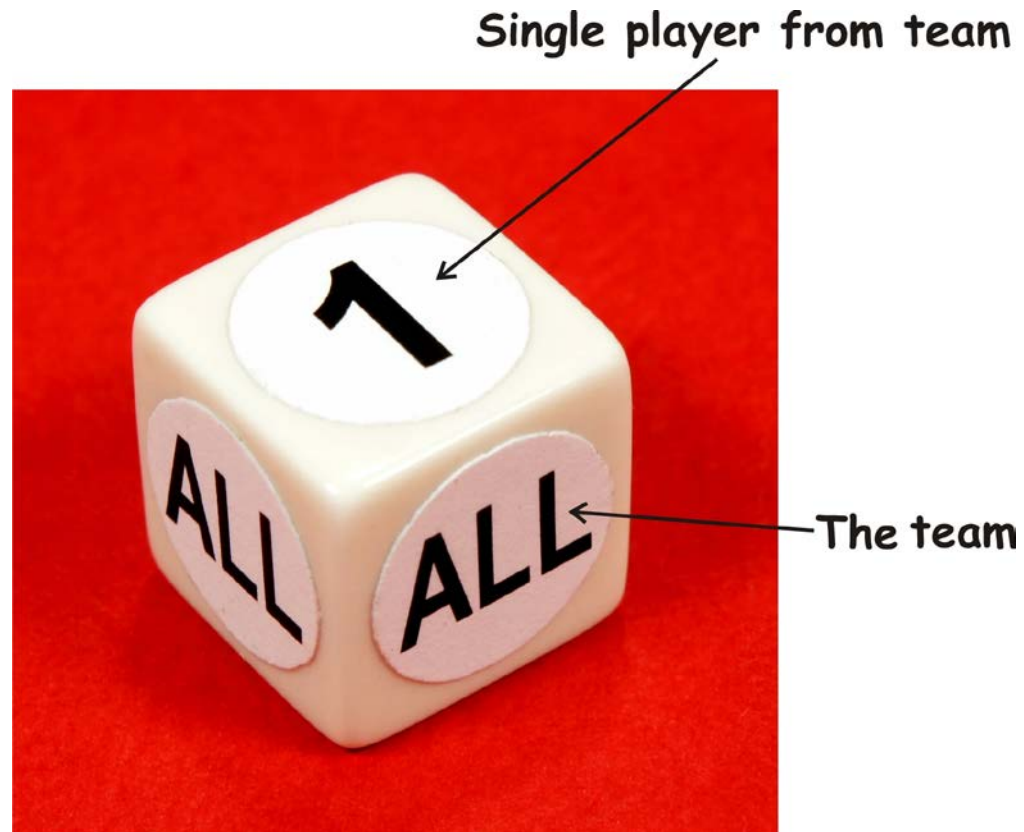
# How to Play the Game



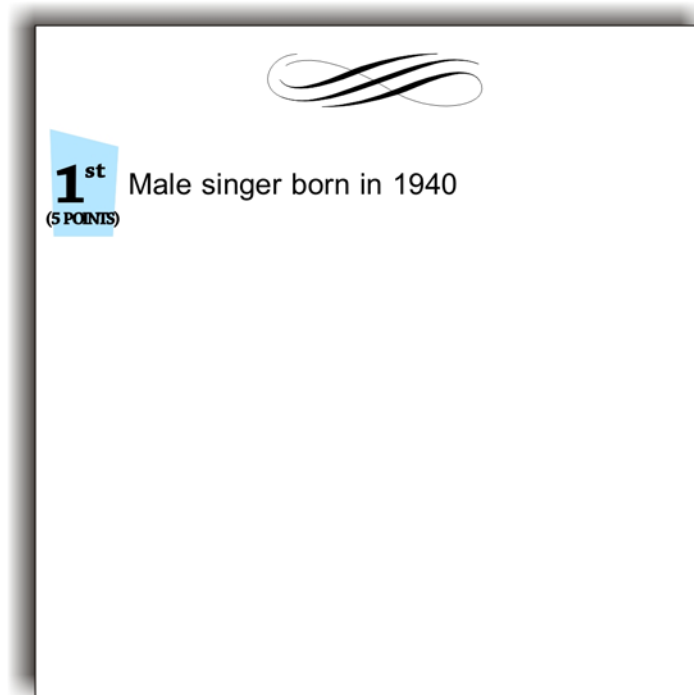
Form two groups. There can be up to 4 people in a group. Give one group the set of 6 prediction cards. These are the cards that the non-playing team uses to try and predict when the other team will guess correctly.



The die is rolled to see if you go by yourself or your team tries to guess the name. Looks like it's up to you!



The other team has read the card to themselves and have predicted when you will guess correctly. Here's the first clue that they will read to you.



Wow! That's pretty wide open. Take a guess!

Here's the second clue they'll read to you.

- 1<sup>st</sup>** Actress born in 1967  
(5 POINTS)
- 2<sup>nd</sup>** She was the first actress to appear on the cover of Vogue  
(4 POINTS)
- 3<sup>rd</sup>** This Academy Award winner once appeared on Sesame Street opposite Elmo  
(3 POINTS)
- 4<sup>th</sup>** Was given the part in her break through role when Molly Ringwald and Meg Ryan turned it down  
(2 POINTS)
- 5<sup>th</sup>** His first name is Julia  
(1 POINT)

Julia Roberts



- 1<sup>st</sup>** Born in Southampton on July 28, 1929  
(5 POINTS)
- 2<sup>nd</sup>** Equestrian interests throughout her life  
(4 POINTS)
- 3<sup>rd</sup>** Married John in Newport, R.I.  
(3 POINTS)
- 4<sup>th</sup>** Third youngest First Lady  
(2 POINTS)
- 5<sup>th</sup>** Later married to shipping magnate Aristotle Onassis  
(1 POINT)

Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis



- 1<sup>st</sup>** Born with the name Temüjin  
(5 POINTS)
- 2<sup>nd</sup>** His father arranged his marriage at age 9 to Borte, the daughter of a rival chief  
(4 POINTS)
- 3<sup>rd</sup>** Used the Silk Road to establish trading partners to form his massive confederation  
(3 POINTS)
- 4<sup>th</sup>** The greatest conqueror of all time, having taken over most of Asia and Europe  
(2 POINTS)
- 5<sup>th</sup>** His initials were G. K.
