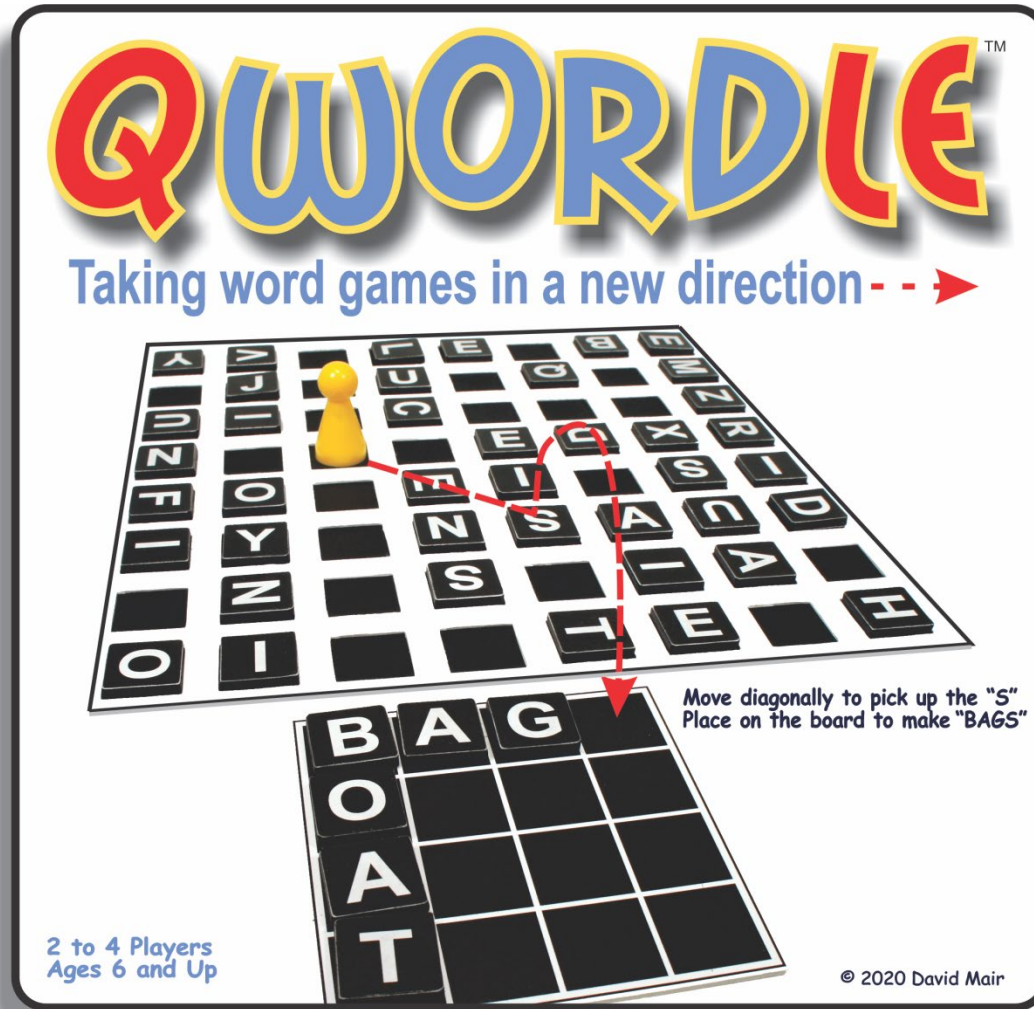


QWORDLE™

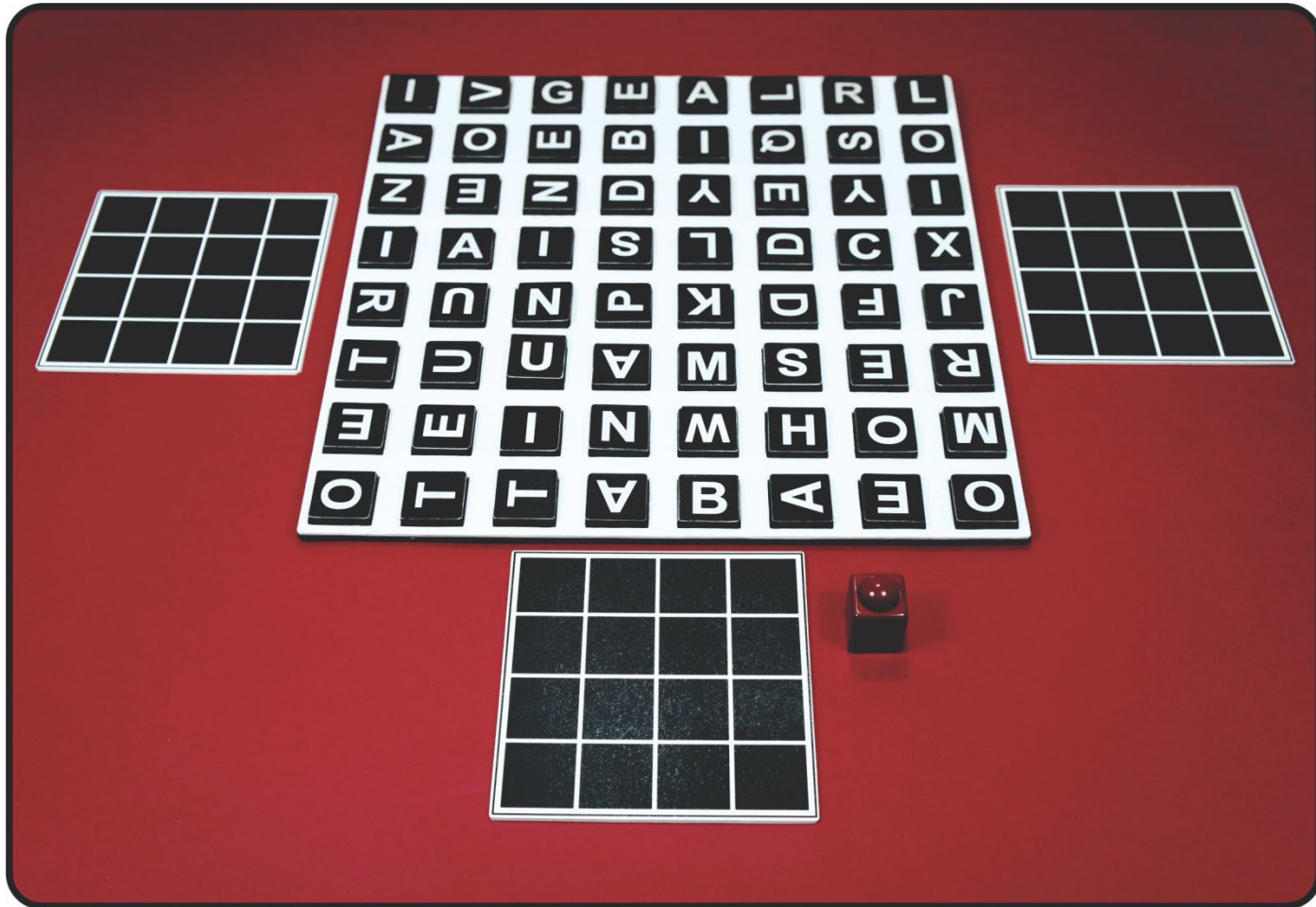
Taking word games in a new direction - - - - -▶

QWORDLE is a 64-piece tile game that can be played as a word game or as a shape and color game, using the look and tiles from the classic Qwirkle tile game.



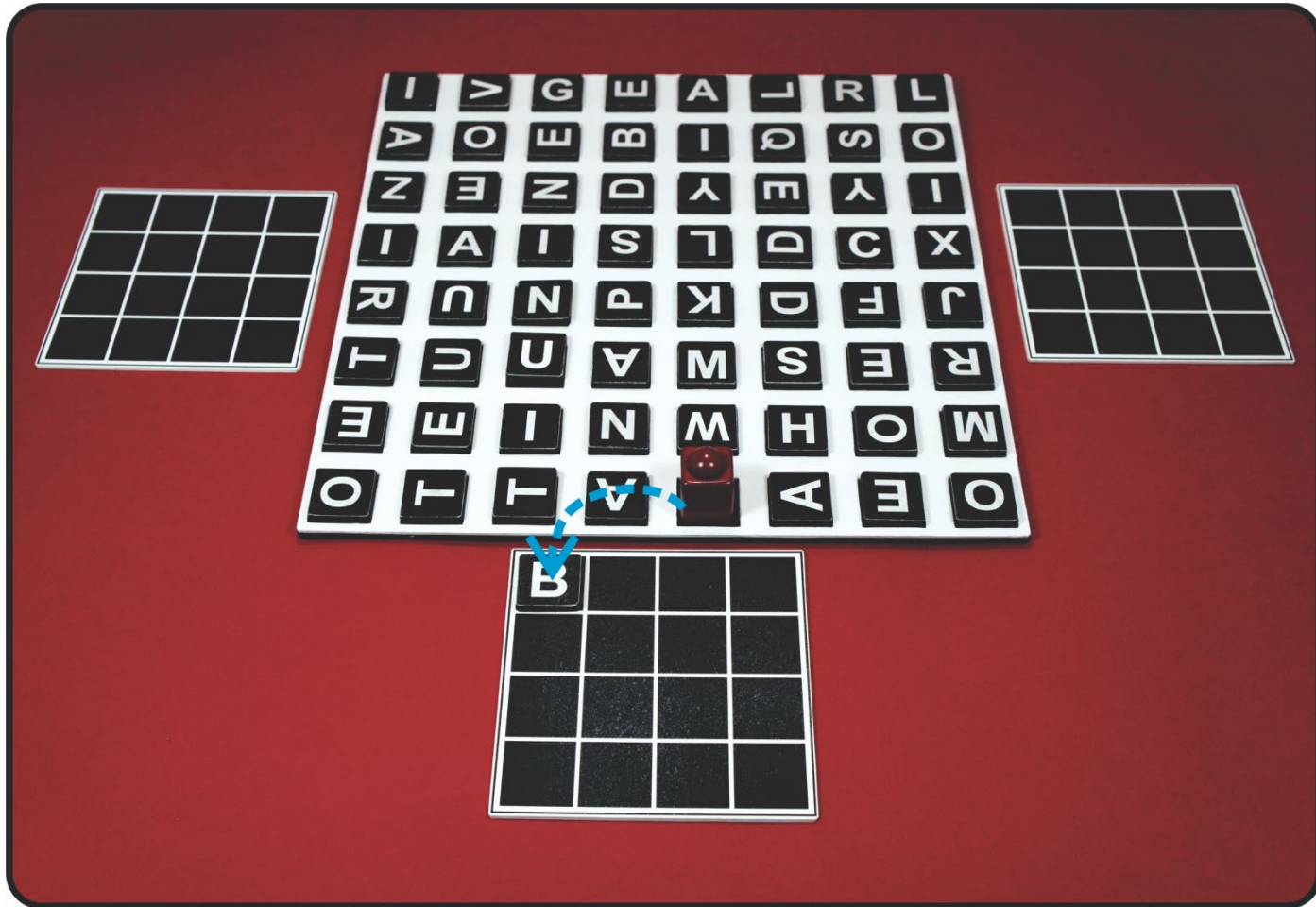
QWORDLE

At the start of play, the 64 letter tiles are randomly placed on the 8 x 8 grid with the playing piece ready to go. Each player is given a 4 x 4 collection grid.



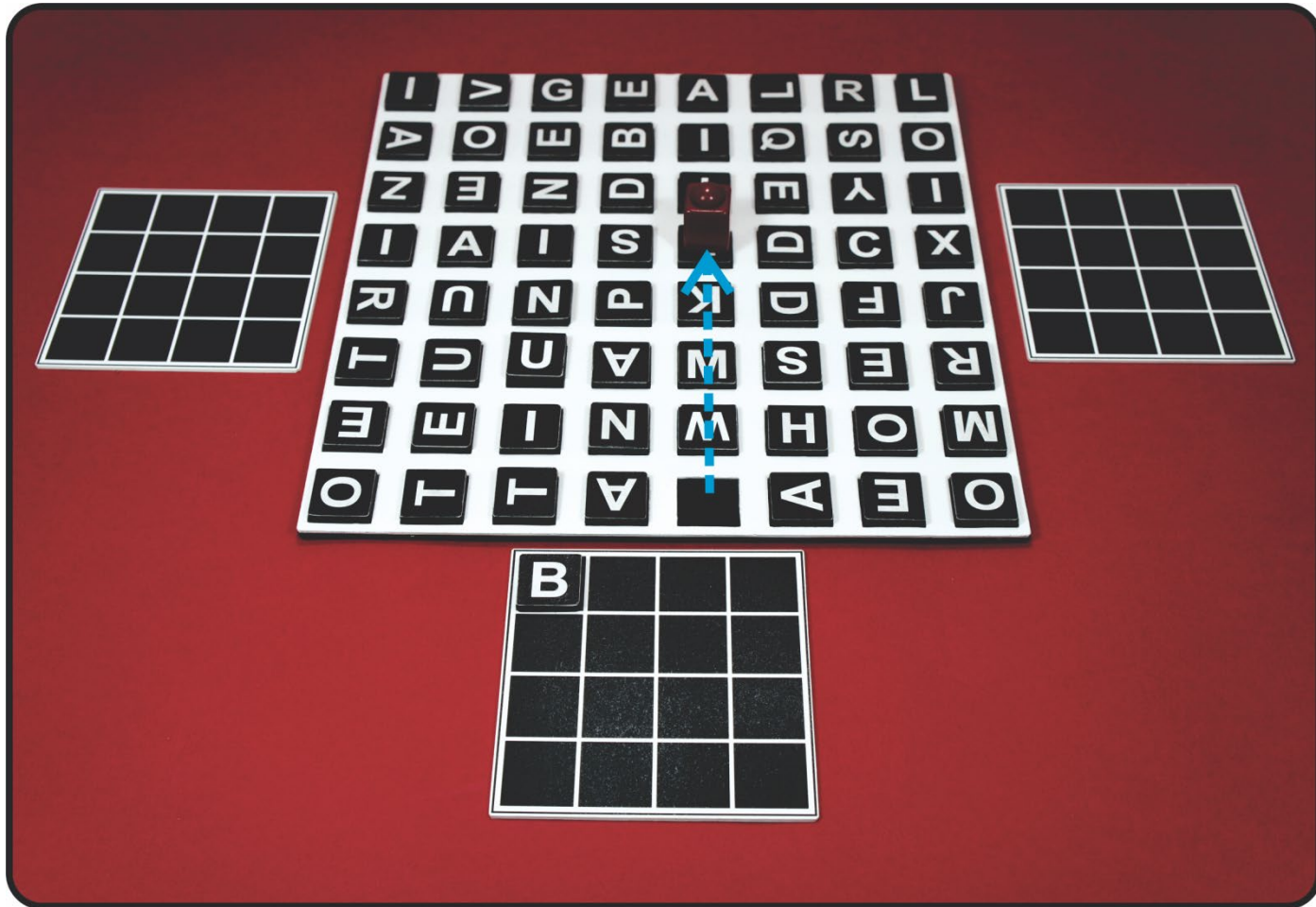
QWORDLE

...and taking a tile (in this case, the letter "B".) Place it anywhere you want on your collection grid. You are trying to form as many 2, 3, and 4 letter words as you can either vertically or horizontally.



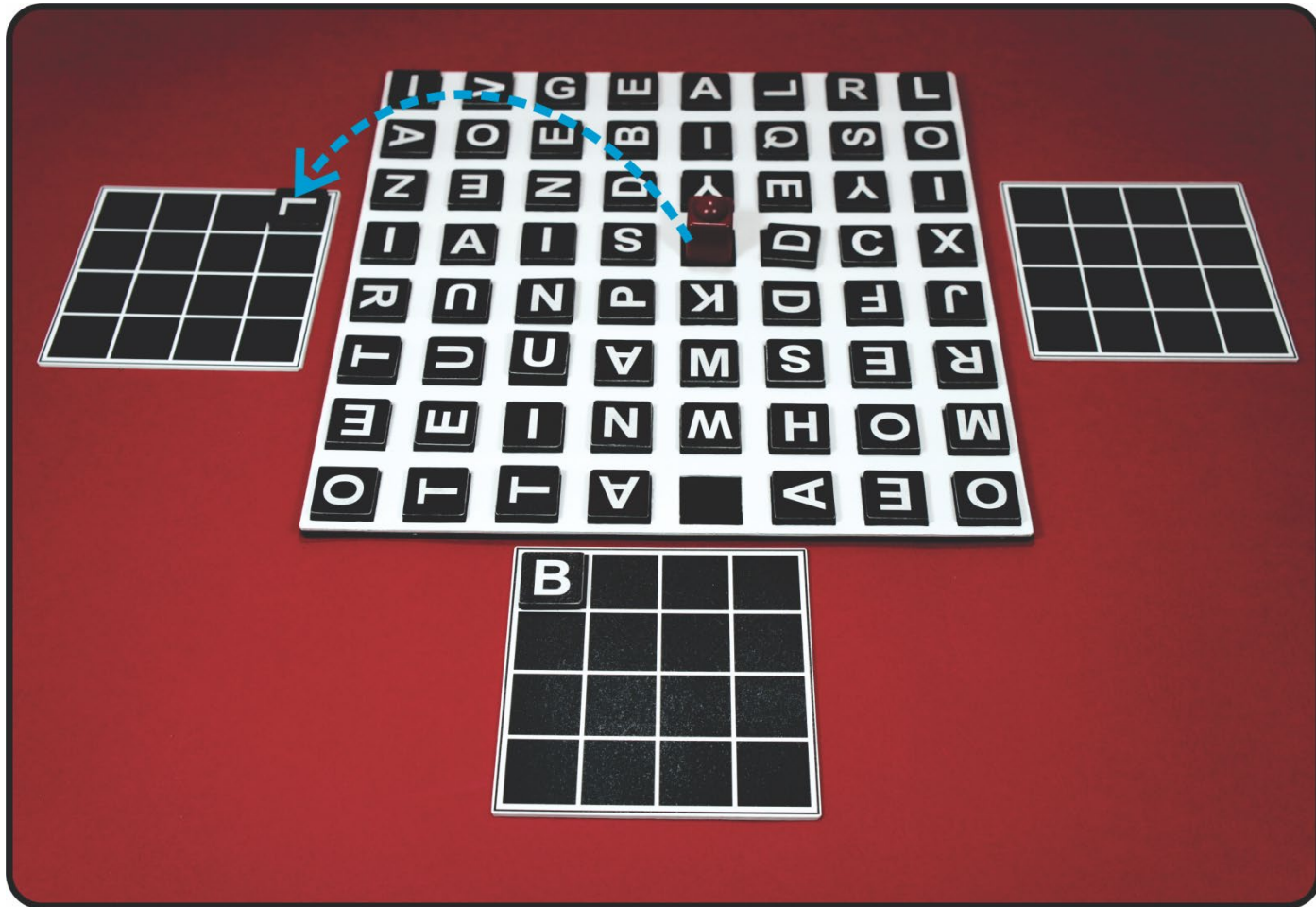
QWORDLE

The player on your left goes next, and can move horizontally or vertically along the row to a tile of their choice.



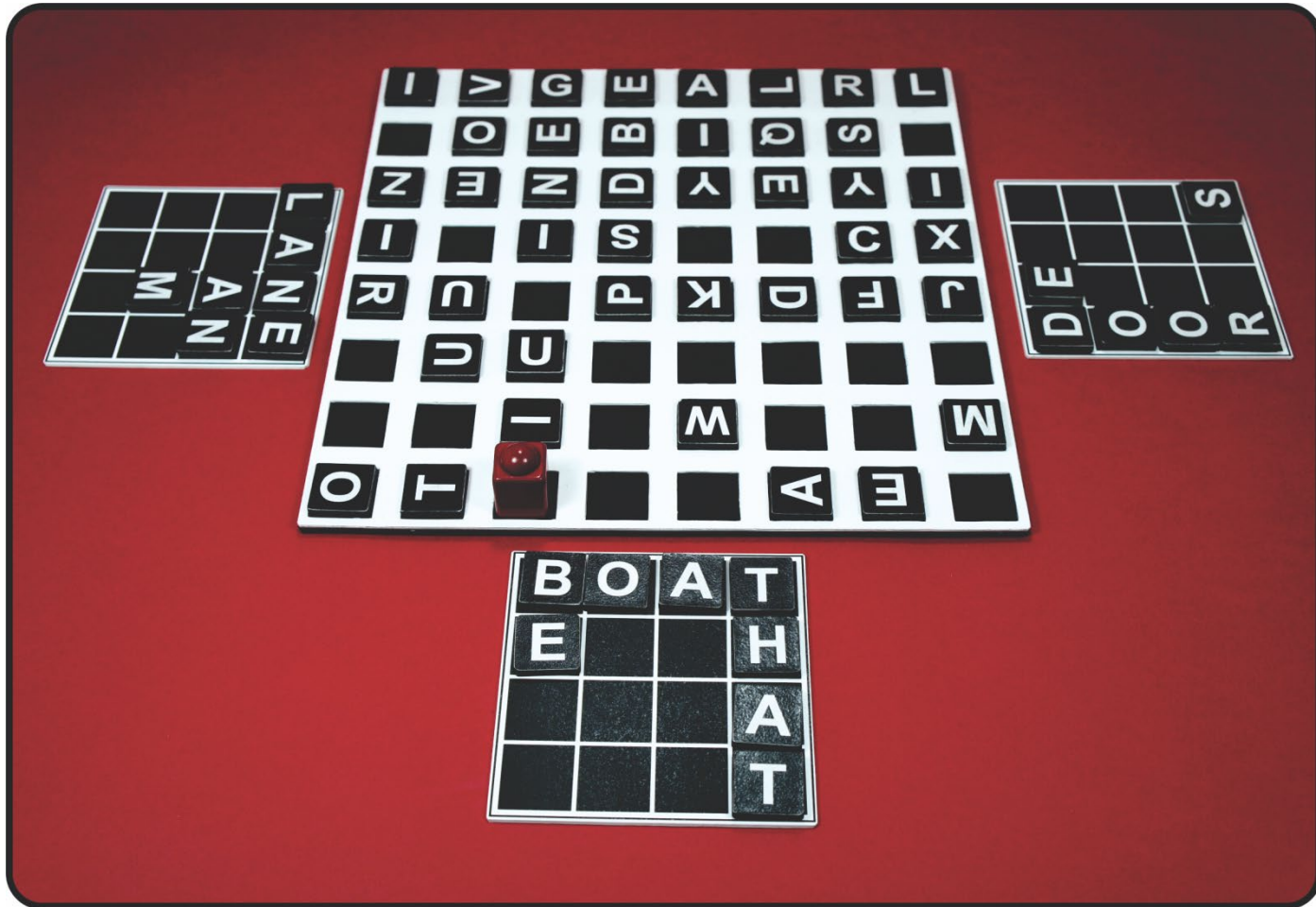
QWORDLE

They have chosen an "L", which is placed on their collection grid.



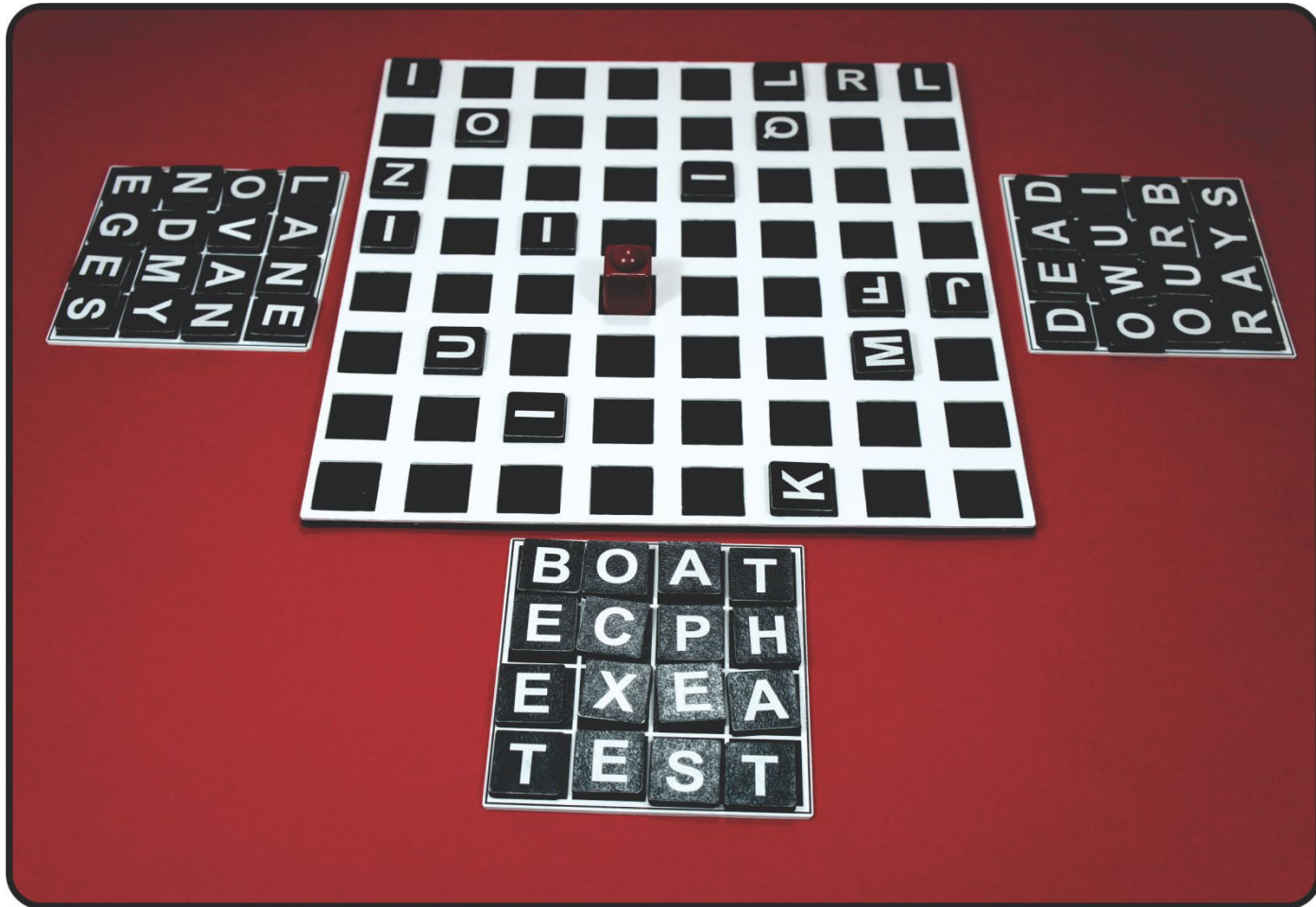
QWORDLE

The game continues with each player choosing a tile from the row they're currently occupying.



QWORDLE

When all the collection grids are filled.....



QWORDLE

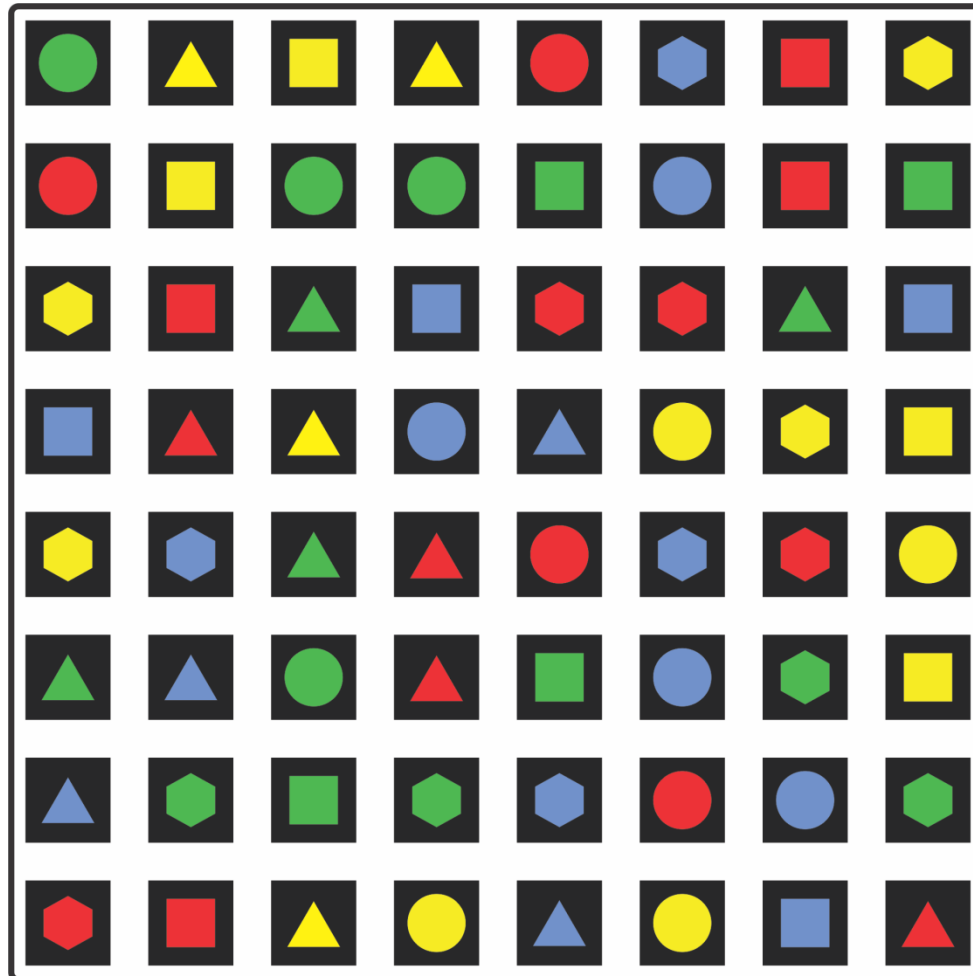
....you add up your score and compare it with the other players. Highest score wins the game!

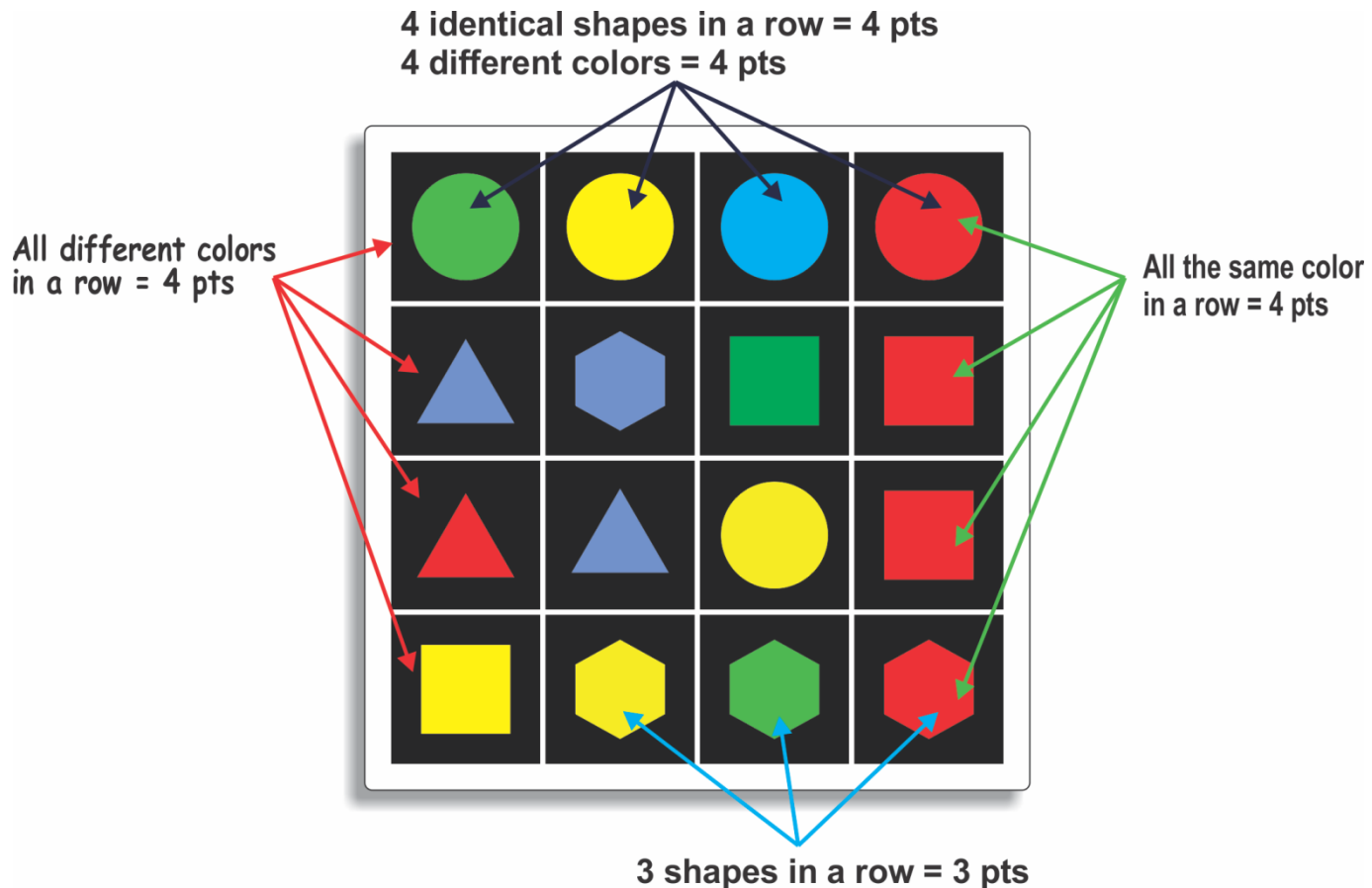
Qwickle GRID

On the back of each of the tiles are 4 different shapes in 4 different colors. The game plays the same way as Qwordle, with players trying to collect combinations of colors or shapes to score.



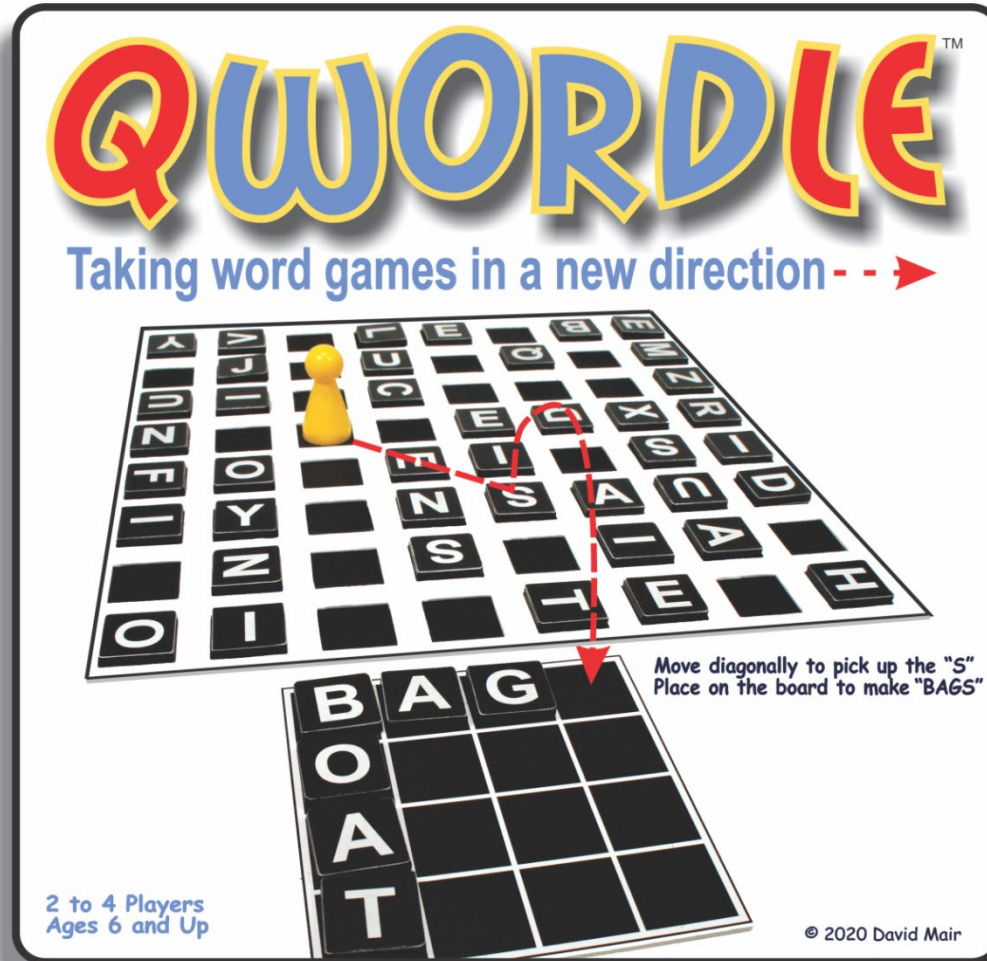
Qwickle GRID

The scores for all the players are compared, and the one with the highest total, wins! The total score for this grid example is 19 points.
