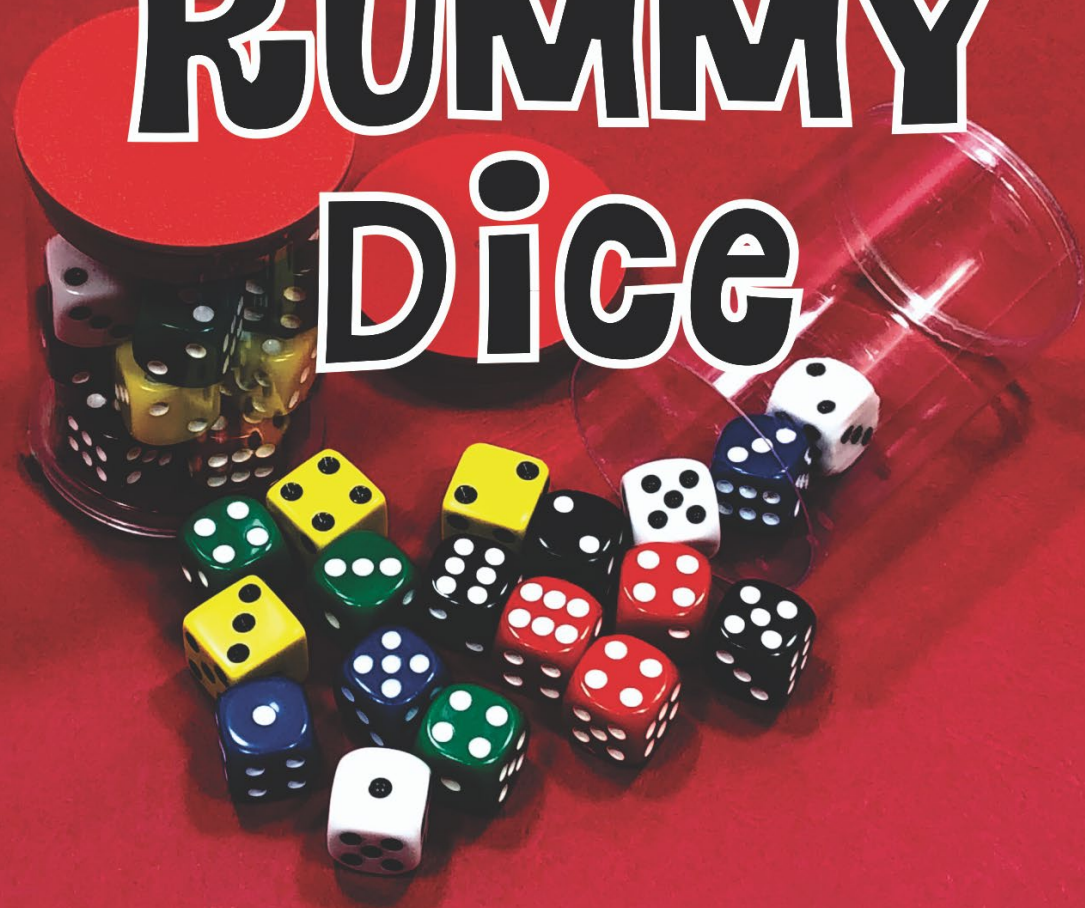


RUMMY Dice



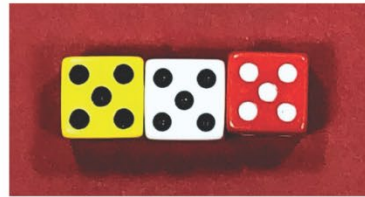
Rummy Dice is the deceptively easy but inherently challenging dice rolling game for 1 or more players or teams of 2 players each. To start the game, roll the dice onto the table.



Start rearranging the dice into "groups" [all the same number] and "runs", [a sequence of consecutive numbers]. In either case, they must all be a different color, and they must use at least 3 dice.

3-dice group

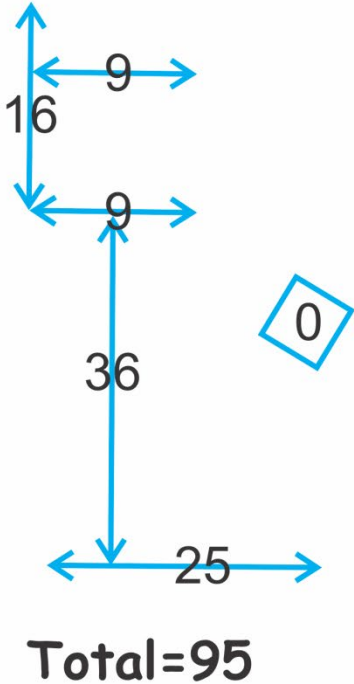
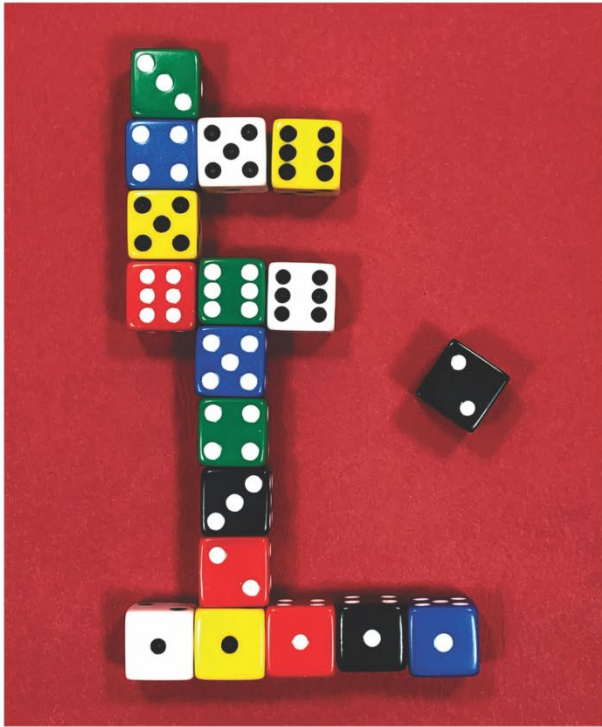


6-dice run

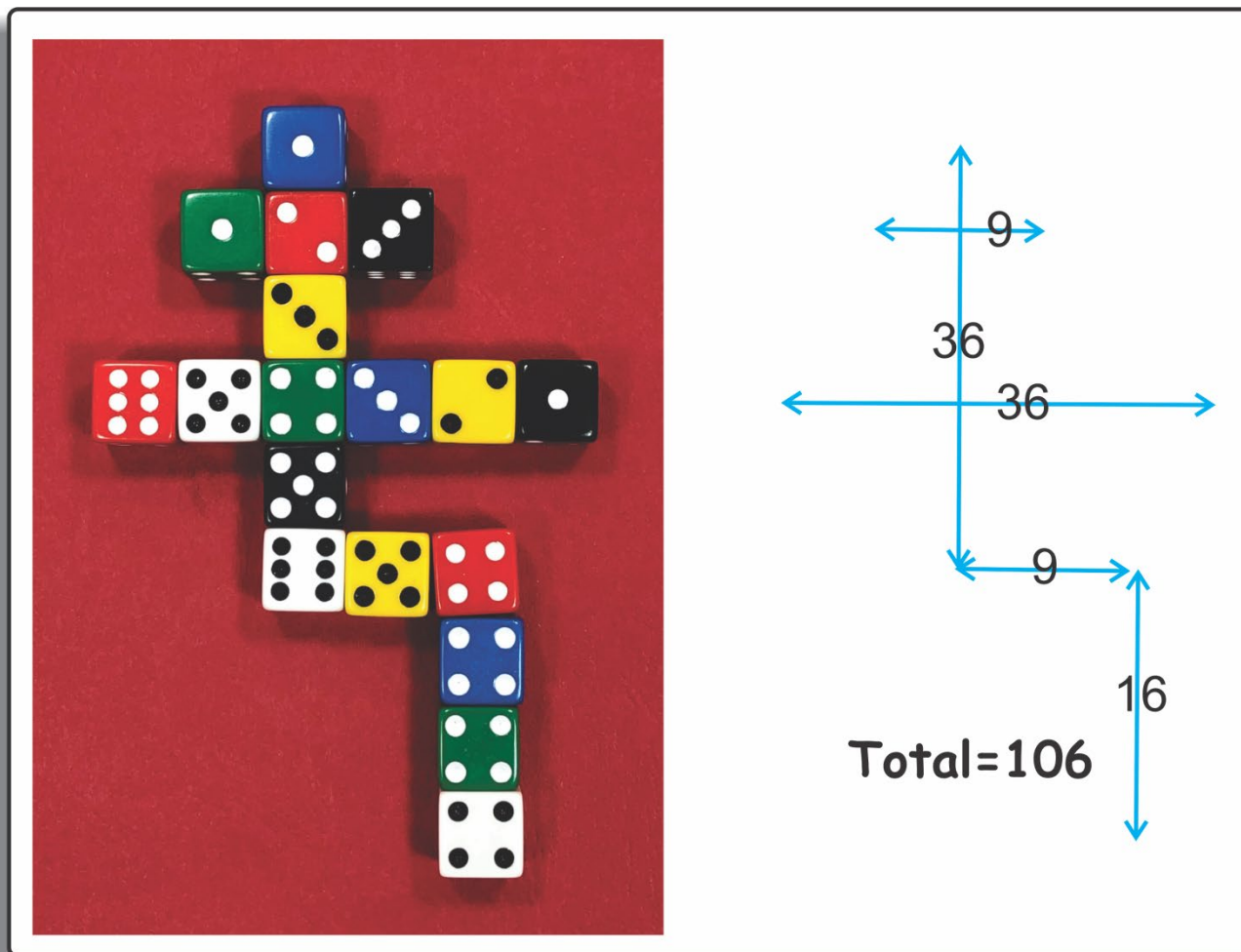


3-dice run

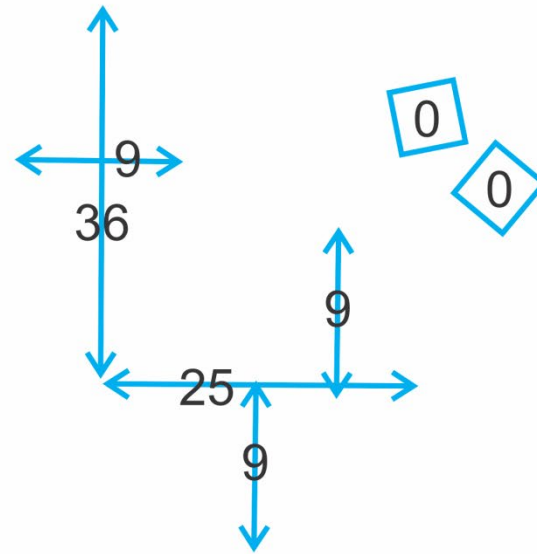
Form the highest scoring set of runs and groups that you can. They all must be connected to one another. You score by multiplying the number of dice used by that same number. A 3-dice set scores 9 (3 x 3), while a 6-dice set is scored as 36. Non-connected dice are not scored.



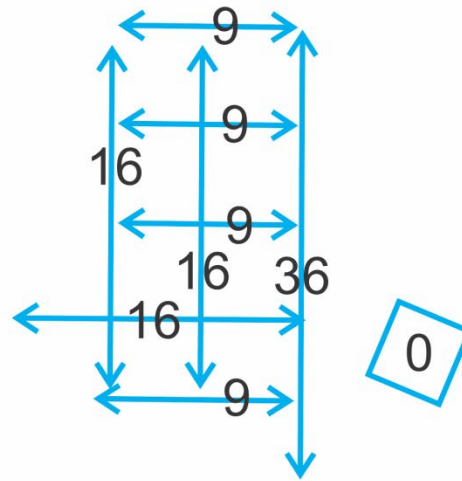
You can play by yourself or in teams of 2 players. Play head to head with two players, or teams going at the same time using their own set of 18 dice. Keep a running total of your scores.

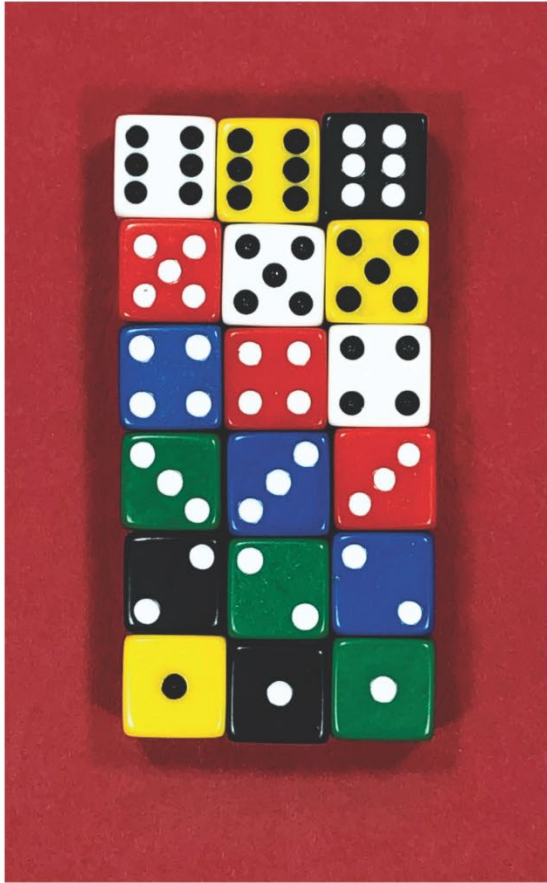


Total=88

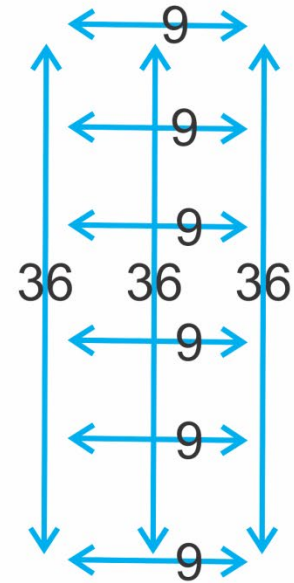


Total=120

There are thousands of permutations, including the ultimate scoring configuration of 162 points.

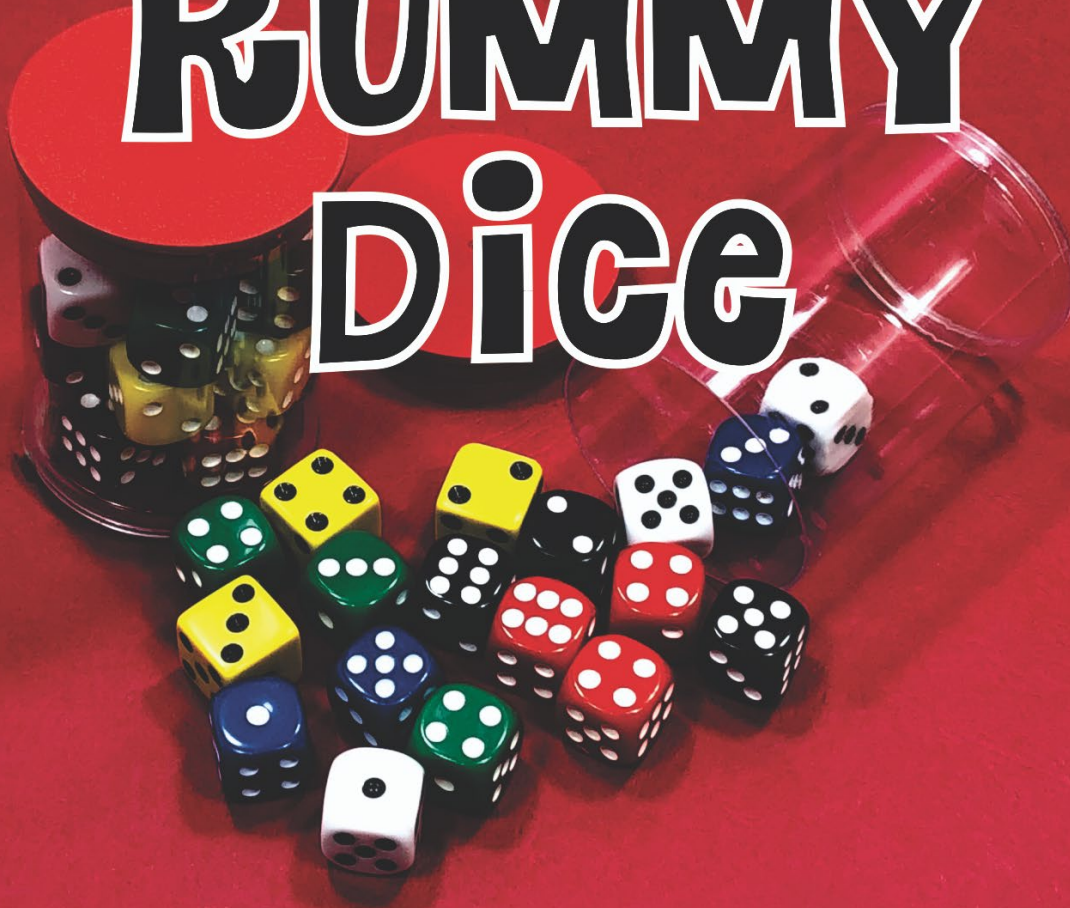


Best possible score
