SHREDDED PUZZLES

The idea for Shredded Puzzles came from 1981 where I saw a newly seeded lawn that was covered with an odd green-colored mulch. On closer inspection, I discovered it was shredded US currency. I took a small handful and "reassembled" a dollar as a sort of art piece.





That lead to this idea many years later; puzzles where all the pieces are long and thin, as if they had gone through a shredder. I call them Shredded Puzzles!

SHREDDED PUZZLES

Shredded Puzzles can be made in many different variations, but the common thread would be that all the pieces of any given puzzle would be the same. The pieces would NOT interlock like a typical jigsaw puzzle, but would be designed to produce the same end results.



SHREDDED PUZZLES

Shredded Puzzles can be designed to include 3 [or more] different levels of difficulty all using the same picture just by die-cutting the pieces in different widths or orientations.

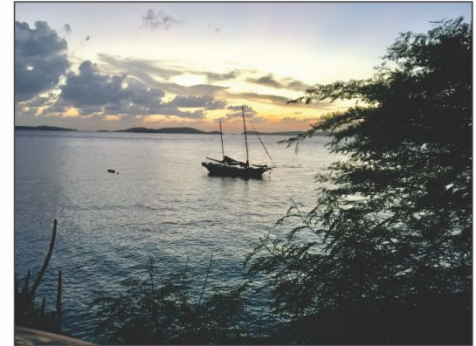

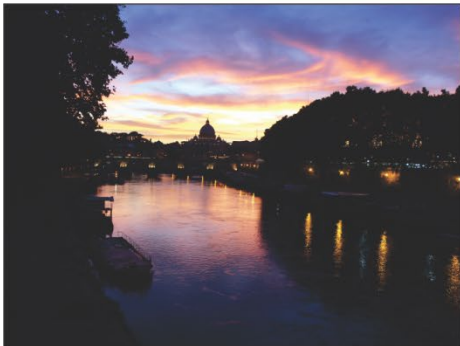

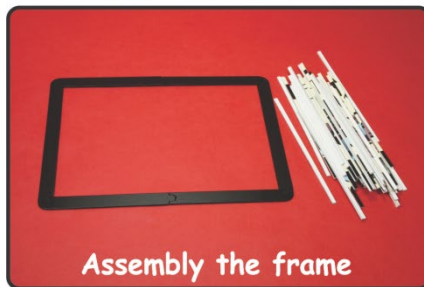
SHREDDED PUZZLES

Because Shredded Puzzles are all long and thin, they can fit easily into very small tubes. Here's a frameless 54 piece Poster Series puzzle of the silent movie Metropolis.



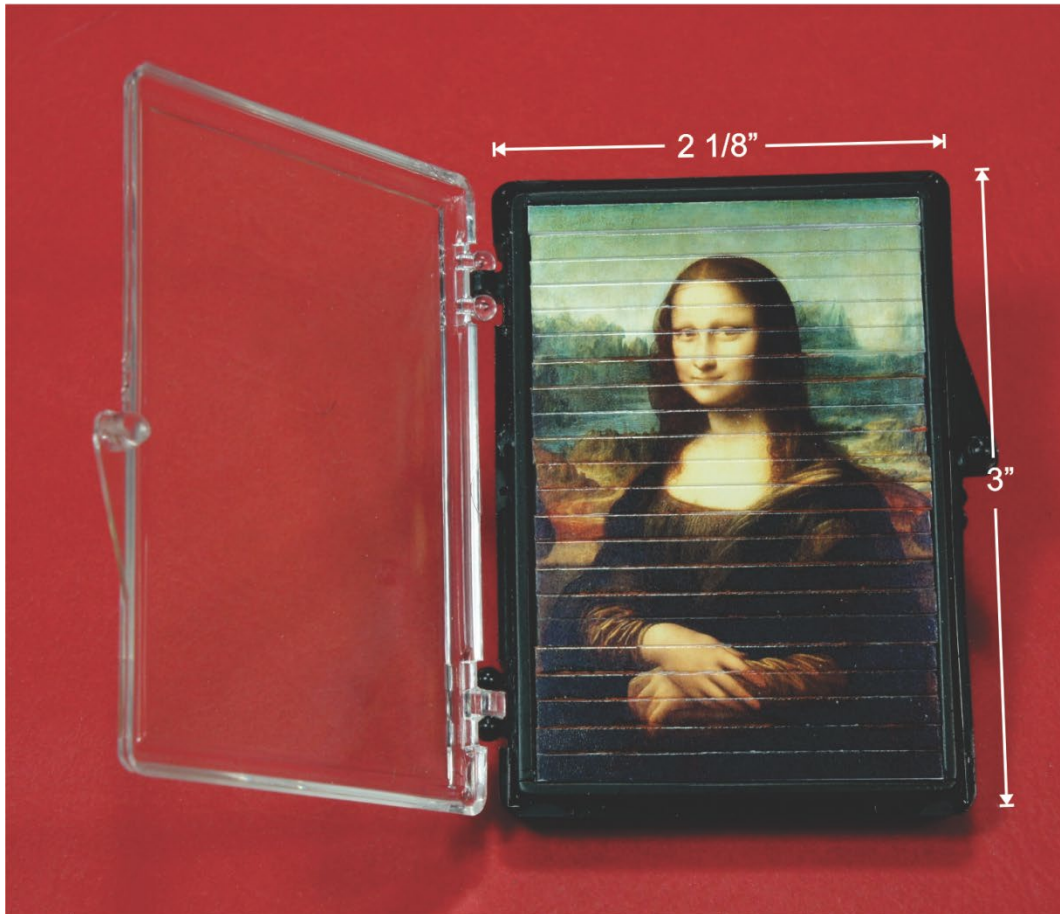
SHREDDED PUZZLES

With a slightly larger diameter tube, a frame to assemble the puzzle can be included.





Shredded Puzzles can be designed to fit in a small plastic case, with an optional set of tweezers for help assembling the puzzle. Everything stores neatly away after use.

Shredded Puzzles can be designed as a gift card/puzzle.
Here's a very easy Tooth Fairy puzzle for a 4 to 6 year old.



SHREDDED PUZZLES

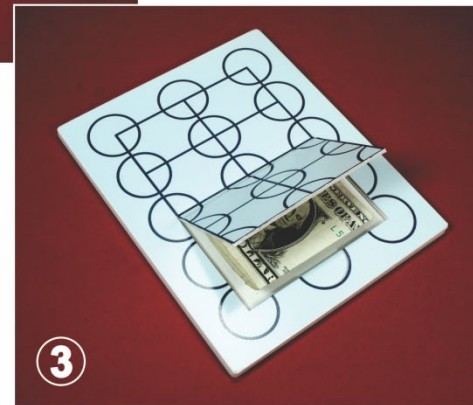
Once the puzzle has been completed, the child reads [or is read] the message. The card is turned over and the hidden compartment is found and opened to reveal the reward.



1 Read the instructions and spill out the pieces.



2 Put the puzzle together, and read the message



3 Turn the card over and lift the hidden flap to find the reward.

The design of the puzzles is not limited to linear pieces. It can be made in a wavy pattern,

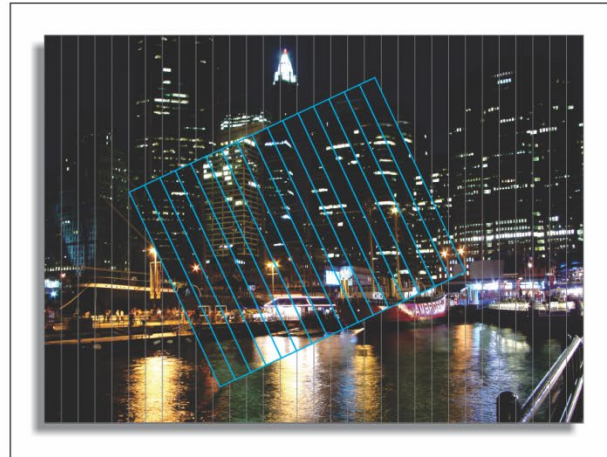
